Courtrooms

4 separate Courtrooms - 3, 10, 11 & 12

- 4 assault trials which will run in the morning simultaneously.
- 4 drugs trials which will run in the afternoon simultaneously.
- 8 teams in total with about 8 to 10 pupils in each team.

For each trial one school team will prosecute and another will defend.

Schools who are prosecuting in the morning (the blue teams) will defend in the afternoon - and vice versa. Blue teams **prosecute** first (the assault). Red teams **defend** first.

The Sheriff will be a senior lawyer in gown and wig.

Prosecution school teams should normally provide

- 2 Prosecution lawyers
- 2 Crown witnesses
- 1 Clerk of Court and
- 1 Policeman (optional)
- 3 Jurors (or some other small number say 3 or 4)

Defence school teams should normally provide

- 2 Defence lawyers
- 2 Defence witnesses (the accused plus one other)
- 1 Court Officer and
- 1 Media person (optional)
- 3 Jurors (or some other small number say 3 or 4)




Team Lists

Each team should also prepare a "list" of the names of those taking part in each trial and their respective roles in that trial. The Clerk of Court and the Court Officer should put their team lists up on the bench for the Sheriff before the trial starts.
